THE INAUGURAL SPINEXPO™ PARIS WAS SUCCESSFULLY HELD FROM THE 6-7 JULY 2016 IN THE HEART OF PARIS' NEW RENOVATED DOCKS, AT LA CITÉ DE LA MODE ET DU DESIGN. THE 2 DAY SHOW HOSTED 80 EXHIBITING COMPANIES WHO MET A TOTAL ATTENDANCE OF 610 VISITORS REPRESENTING 321 COMPANIES, WITH A NUMBER OF RE-ENTRIES OF 710 VISITORS.



SPINEXPO™ has now established itself as the leading international platform for both knitwear professionals looking for genuine, creativity and innovation, and the wider industry looking for quality and creative products. With an international stage, SPINEXPO™ benefits from being able to allow each country to shape the show to its own characteristics and cultural trends. Our first event in Paris was no exception to this as the SPINEXPO™ team drew influence from the city's fashion heritage. It was evident that the Paris show, in only its first year, has become a « B to B » platform, with top quality suppliers meeting top quality brands. Our aim in starting this new show was to allow exhibitors from outside Europe to show their collections in a sophisticated, fashion orientated, environment in the heart of Europe.

SPINEXPO™ is an « easy to work » and small show addressing major mid to high end European brands who are becoming the new area of focus for every supplier. At a time where lowering margins on volume orders implies that suppliers are starting to change their way of working by targeting good niche brands that want



better products, SPINEXPO™ Paris aims at enlarging their visibility in Europe. As can be seen that France dominates the attached list of visiting companies, followed by the UK, Germany, Netherlands, Spain, Belgium, Italy and Scandinavia. The Paris show welcomed a large number of companies, with skilled buyers and no more than 1 to 2 members of the company and ensuring, where possible, that senior staff members attend to make business matters as efficient as possible.

The Paris show is different from New York, where we welcome a large number of designers from the same company, or from Shanghai where we welcome an even larger number of visitors.

In reflection of its commitment to innovation, SPINEXPO™ is already exploring the opportunity of having the second Paris show starting on a Monday and designing a 3-day show experience in 2017.

Paris was selective all the way, from exhibitor to visiting brand. We want it to remain that way and increase the number of visitors
